### Road Safety

Most years I write about road safety. On many of the previous occasions there has been a reason to bring this topic up – usually an incident or a close call. Recently, I was visited by some folk who nearly knocked over some of our students on a pedestrian crossing. The good news is that the problem was not how our students used the crossing but rather cars parked too close to the crossing making it difficult for the driver to see anyone on the crossing. I have asked for yellow 'no stopping' lines to be painted near the crossing.

This event seemed as good a time as any to remind you of the important job we all have as adults to be role models and teachers of road safety habits.

As parents you have an important job in role modelling many appropriate safety behaviours. This is especially the case around road safety. I regularly see people (children, adults and adults leading children) crossing roads near pedestrian crossings. I know that these crossings were carefully and deliberately placed around the village to help people and children in particular get wherever they are going safely. It is, in my opinion, risky, even dangerous, for people not to use them.

I know that this is a (road) safe community. A 30 km per hour speed limit means most drivers can stop quickly if necessary. However, even at this speed someone could get quite badly hurt if there was a collision between them and a motor vehicle.

I know that many of you drop off and collect your children each day and I also see and hear many of you actively teaching road safety to your children. It's when you are not with them and they are out and about that the real test of the road safety messages you give become evident. Your road safety teaching and role modelling are important ways in which road safety messages are taught and reinforced.

Thanks for your help with this.
