Linton Camp School has had a bilingual class for more than fifteen years. Very few schools in Manawatu offer bilingual education and fewer have had a class in operation as long as we have.

In 2021 our bilingual class is open to all students in Years 1-3, regardless of their ability in Te Reo. While teaching in Reading, Writing and Mathematics is done in English the tikanga of the class and instructions are all in Te Reo. This is what makes the class unique. The students get immersed in Te Ao Maori everyday. They learn Te Reo, they learn tikanga, they learn waiata and they learn to see the world from a different perspective.

Recently, a parent described being part of the class as being an enriching experience. She said her son has grown in confidence and was really enjoying all the activities and learning that was going on in the classroom.

There will be a new teacher taking our bilingual class next year. The appointment process is well

To be really successful the bilingual class needs a class full of students. We do not get extra staffing to have a bilingual class. So, as you can imagine, it won't be ok to have one room with a lot of students beside another room with a much smaller number of students.

As I said above bilingual education is something unique at Linton Camp School. I'm confident your child(ren) will really enjoy learning Te Reo and tikanga alongside all the other aspects of the curriculum should you choose to have them in this class.
